### **Catalog Course Description**

The life and writings of ten influential theologians from across the history of the Christian tradition, to examine how theology, ministry, and vocation develop in context.

### **Specific Course Goals**

In this course you will receive support to help you build and refine a substantial part of the context for theological work in the Christian tradition. Specifically, you will have the opportunity to

- 1) develop skills of careful analysis and reflection.
- 2) express and test those skills in written and oral forms.
- 3) practice discerning challenges for the tradition.
- 4) see how theologians have recognized their calling.
- 5) understand and evaluate what past theologians have contributed.
- 6) gain expertise in the life and thought of several theologians most important to your work.
- 7) consider the implications of theology for Christian life and the practice of ministry.
- 8) raise questions of particular interest to you.

### **Evaluation**

Ten percent for consistent and thoughtful participation in class.

Ten percent for your presentation which will briefly respond to three orienting questions:

- 1) what key theological challenges did the church face during the life time of the theologian you are investigating?
- 2) how did the theologian know what he or she should do?
- 3) what did the theologian contribute?

Your presentation in written form is due at the class one week before it is to be discussed. Provide a copy for the professor and each member of the seminar.

Ten percent for your assigned critique of another participant's presentation on the three centered questions.

Ten percent for your work as a facilitator of an assigned class.

Ten percent for your record of an assigned class. These notes will be copied to the presenter, critic, facilitator, and professor.

Fifty percent for your term paper.
