Catalog Course Description

The life and writings of ten influential theologians from across the history of the Christian tradition, to examine how theology, ministry, and vocation develop in context.

Course Objectives

This course will help you to build and refine part of the context for theological work in the Christian tradition. As you begin to pursue a Ph.D. or other advanced degree in Christian Theology, it is useful to realize that you are not the first one to pursue this vocation. We can learn much from the experience of our predecessors.

As an interdisciplinary course, we will primarily engage theology, ethics, history, and ministry, but Biblical studies, a prominent field in the Christian tradition and probably of particular interest to some of the class participants, will also play a role.

Knowing

- see how theologians have recognized their calling
- understand and evaluate what past theologians have contributed
- gain expertise in the life and thought of several theologians important to your work

Being

- perceptive of cultural challenges
- encouraged at how God has worked before
- open to how God might call one today

Doing

- develop skills of careful analysis and reflection
- practice discerning challenges for the tradition
- consider the implications of theology for Christian life and the practice of ministry
- recognize personal vocation

Evaluation

Twelve percent for consistent and thoughtful participation in class

Twenty-four percent for your paper and presentation on three centered questions and following discussion

Twelve percent for role as first respondent to another participant's presentation

Twelve percent for your work as a facilitator of an assigned class

Forty percent for your term research paper (due by 7 pm April 1)

Presentation instructions

Roles as class presenter, first responder, and facilitator will be assigned by turn at the first class, using a different roster order for each category so that everyone has an early choice in one category. Your research paper is not limited to the theologian about whom you present, respond to, or facilitate.

Your presentation paper will address in less than 2000 words, three orienting questions:

- 1) What key challenges did the church face during the life time of the theologian you are investigating?
- 2) How did the theologian recognize what she should address?
- 3) What did the theologian contribute for her time and ours?

Granted the fastest way to download this content would be for the instructor to lecture these points, but a central goal in an advanced degree level seminar is to develop research, judgment, and presentation skills in the participants. There is no substitute for actual experience, so this class allows you to practice three primary skill sets while pursuing important content.

The paper is to be emailed as early as possible to all class members. At the latest, you should send your paper by Monday 9:00 a.m. one week before it is to be discussed. After 9:00 a.m. the paper loses one mark gradation per twenty-four hours or fraction of it. For example A to A-, B+ to B. In class you will be able to count on your fellow students having read the paper, so your initial ten minute presentation will highlight, retract, and/or adjust as you think would be most helpful.

First Responder

The first responder has carefully read the paper to be presented and researched the assigned questions, so that she can praise the author for success, test claims where they are questionable, and add insight. This is a standard role in academic life, such as at conferences and for peer reviewed journals, book reviews, and editing. There is a skill in making friends with critique while also moving the discussion forward. The critique should aim both to respect and challenge compatriots to their best effort. The respondent has ten minutes and is not expected to provide any written documentation unless helpful to her case. The presenter will then have first response to the respondent.

Facilitator

The role of facilitator is another common one in academia. Whether presiding at a conference, coordinating an anthology, chairing a curriculum meeting, or teaching a seminar, a professor needs to develop skills of drawing out the contribution of all present to build understanding and effective action. The facilitator will convene class on time with prayer, make all feel welcome, start the presenter and first respondent at the right times, be sure they end on time, encourage all to take part, have questions ready to drive the discussion in fruitful directions as needed, summarize, thank, and protect five minutes at the end for the professor to highlight skills and content.

Paper instructions

Your research paper thesis may be directly related to a theologian that you presented, responded to,

or facilitated, but it does not have to be. The advanced degree program encourages works of about 6,000 words as typical of published papers. The papers should be submitted according to the *Chicago Manual of Style* (standard for publication in theology and the humanities) or the MacDiv Style Guide, which can be found on the web at: <http://www.macdiv.ca/students/documents/MacStyleGuideApr1508.pdf>. As to electronic format, the paper is due in a version of Word (doc. docx. Word for Mac) by e-mail by 7 pm April 1. Earlier submission is encouraged. Each twenty-four hour period or fraction, after 7 pm April 1 incurs a reduction of one mark gradation such as from A to A-, B+ to B...

As an important part of clarity in your own mind and communication to others, please use standard English. Note the following checklist:

Block quote any quotation more than three lines long. Block quotes are single spaced with indented margins and no quotation marks.

Use footnotes. They may be in any standard format provided all of the relevant information is included and you are consistent throughout the paper. *The Chicago Manual of Style* is the most widely used authority for works in theology and philosophy.

Book and journal titles receive italics. Article titles are placed in quotes.

Do not use no double negative.

Verbs has to agree with their subjects.

Make each pronoun agree with their antecedent

Do not write run on sentences since they are hard to follow and understand for those who are reading your thoughts and seeking to gain from your insights born of experience and careful reflection in this academic endeavor we rightfully treasure highly, as well we should.

About them sentence fragments.

Just between you and I, case is important too.

Try to not often, or maybe even never, split infinitives.

Ones apostrophe's should be used correctly.

Don't use contractions in a formal essay.
