



Faculty Position in New Testament and Linguistics

In support of the mission of an evangelical seminary, the position requires expertise that will advance both Professional Degree students (M.T.S., M.Div.) and specialized Advanced Degree students (M.A., Ph.D.).

Requirements

Ph.D. or equivalent in a suitable field, proven scholarly record, teaching experience (preferably in a seminary), and a commitment to the dynamic evangelical ethos of the College.

Responsibilities

- teaching and mentoring both professional and advanced students in New Testament studies;
- coordinating the Centre for Biblical Linguistics, Translation, and Exegesis;
- teaching introductory and advanced Greek language and linguistics courses;
- willingly recruiting and supervising M.A./Ph.D. degree students;
- contributing to scholarship in concert with current faculty in Biblical Studies;
- support and develop the SFL and related approach of current New Testament faculty;
- general supporting of the work of the College (committees, etc.).

Women and minorities are encouraged to apply. Salary and benefits are commensurate with qualifications.
