### Student Cards & Validation Stickers

**New students:** you are required to complete the enclosed *New Student Form* and submit a recent, original passport-sized photo for your student card to the **Student Records Office**.

**New & Returning Students:** Once the registration process is complete and you have been financially cleared by the university, you will be given a validation sticker to attach to your student card. This will allow you to access the many different campus facilities including Mills Library.

### Registration

**Important:** Registration forms and payment are due to the **Student Records Office, Room 210** by **July 16, 2011**.

**Note: A fee of \$35 (payable to McMaster Divinity College) will be charged for registrations received after July 16, 2011.**

- A timetable has been included to assist you in scheduling your courses.
- For a more comprehensive course review, refer to the course **syllabi** (available online - [www.macdiv.ca](http://www.macdiv.ca) under the Current Students tab).
- A *sample* registration form is attached. To minimize errors, we ask that you refer to it as you complete your own registration form. If you have any questions, please contact the **Student Records Office**.

### Tuition Rates and Fees

Please see the attached fee schedules for both resident and visa students. The final three columns show your total fees (depending on your level and the number of courses you are registering for).

### Payment Options

All registrations are based on the successful receipt of payment for the desired courses. There are several methods of payment:

1. **On-line payment is the preferred method of payment:**
  - a. **MUGSI** (your McMaster student account)
    - i. On [www.mcmaster.ca](http://www.mcmaster.ca), select MUGSI. Then select New Student Portal which will allow you to login to MACCESS. From there select Financials, then MUGSI. You will be required to begin a new session again at this point. Then under Quick Links select My Student Accounts. Select Pay Now. Your payment will be processed immediately. This confirmation number *must be* recorded on the payment arrangement form.
    - ii. **On-line banking:** McMaster University should be set up as a "payee" through your personal bank. Your student number is the designated account number. After the transfer is complete, a confirmation number is given. This confirmation number *must be* recorded on the payment arrangement form.
2. A payment made by **cheque** must be made payable to **McMaster University**. You *must* include your **student number** in the memo section of your cheque. Please send the registration form and cheque to **McMaster Divinity College**.
3. **Installment and monthly** payment plans are arranged through Student Accounts and Cashiers in Gilmour Hall, McMaster University (GH 120). The office can be contacted at (905) 525-9140 ext 24478 or at [student.accounts@mcmaster.ca](mailto:student.accounts@mcmaster.ca). Please submit a copy of the approved arrangement paperwork along with your registration.

Each of these options requires that the **Payment Arrangement Form** be submitted at the time of your registration.

## Taking Off-Campus Courses (LOP)

An application for a letter of permission (LOP) is available in the **Student Records Office**, Room 210, or on our **website** at <http://www.macdiv.ca/regs/permission.php>. Requested Letter of Permission courses should be:

- offered through an ATS Accredited school *AND*
- the course should not be offered at McMaster Divinity College during the same term.

Further information regarding registering and regulations for Letter of Permission courses may be found on our website.

## Drop/Add Courses

You can amend your course choices by completing a drop/add form. Any changes that are made to your selections must be received by **Friday, September 16** to avoid financial penalties. The last day to cancel a course without *failure* is **Friday, November 11**.

## MUGSI

MUGSI is your online information portal. You can view your grades, academic information, financial aid details etc. Please ensure that you create a username and password for your MUGSI account as soon as possible.



### Terms and Conditions:

1. The non-refundable **\$35 Per-Term Flex Plan Fee** will be charged once in **each** of the 3 terms. FLEX PLAN 1 (charged in October), FLEX PLAN 2 (charged in each October and February), FLEX PLAN 3 (charged in each October, February and June) as long as an unpaid balance is carried. Paying off your account in full before the end of a term will avoid this charge.
2. After the initial payment is made, no later than September 1<sup>st</sup>, the balance of your fees can be paid anytime, in any increment between September 2 and November 30 (FLEX PLAN 1), March 15<sup>th</sup> (FLEX PLAN 2) and July 15<sup>th</sup> (FLEX PLAN 3). You may choose to pay using equal monthly payments.
3. Interest is charged at the annual rate of 14.4% (1.2% per month compounded) subject to change.
4. The initial and subsequent monthly payment amounts are based on the amounts indicated on the front of this Payment Agreement Form (PAF).
5. If payments are made monthly, as recommended above, there may be a residual amount owing at the end of the plan. **It is the student's responsibility to check their student Account Statement** on MUGSI **regularly** and pay any balance owing on their Account Statement to avoid late payment charges, delays in the release of final grades, transcripts or diplomas or future registrations.
6. A Late Payment Fee of \$35 will be charged when balances are not paid in full by the end of the plan.
